## Licence Requirements THE NEW MOTORCYCLE LICENCING LAWS FROM 1st FEBRUARY 2001

All candidates taking either a restricted test (125cc) or Direct Access Test (DAS) will have to pass theory test. The theory test cannot be taken until the CBT has been passed. These tests are taken to a Driving Standards Agency test Centre.

The CBT will last for 2 years (currently it lasts for three)

Any car driver who wishes to ride a moped (Under 50cc and design speed less than 31mph) and has passed his/her car test after 01/02/2001 will have to pass a CBT before allowed on the road.

Car drivers who have passed their test before 01/02/2001 will not have to complete a CBT.

All provisional licences issued after 01/02/2001, will no longer have the 2 year limit to the motor cycle entitlement, they will last indefinitely.
